The itinerary includes:

- Day 1: Arrival at Imperial Hotel Delhi. Tour of Connaught area and Qutab Minar, welcome dinner at Olives*.
- Day 2: Tour Old Delhi, Jama Masjid, Humayun's Tomb with historian Sam Dalrymple, shopping at Khan Market.
- Day 3: Travel to by early morning train to Agra, tour Taj Mahal and Red Fort, stay at Taj View Palace.
- Day 4: Visit Sokundra Fort in Agra. Travel to Jaipur, check into 47 Jobner Bagh.
- Day 5: VIP tour for first half of the day to Jaipur City Palace, Kings Astrological Observatory called Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal. Spend the afternoon independently.
- Day 6: Visit Amber Fort, Step Wells, Anohki Museum in Jaipur in the morning. Free time in the afternoon.
- Day 7: Optional morning activities that include Laughing Yoga, flower market visit, and Masala Chai spot in Jaipur**. Group tour of Nila House with indigo dying lessons in the afternoon.
- Day 8: Fly to Udaipur, VIP City Palace tour. Afternoon free. Rooftop dinner at Taj Lake Palace*.
